Horizon is a highly equipped car and has many built in features which others regard as extras. All these are standard on the LS model. Heated rear screen. Hazard warning flashers. Rear fog lamps. Concealed inertia-reel

front safety belts. Soft rim steering wheel. Carpets.



The style of wheel illustrated on the GL model will be changed in production in 1980 model year.

Driver's door mirror. Armrests. Load adjustable headlamps plus a battery of ten watch-dog warning lights to keep the driver fully informed at all times. Horizon leaves nothing to chance.



The GL adds halogen headlamps, reverse lamps, tailgate wash/wipe, remote control driver's door mirror and push button radio.



The GLS has laminated windscreen, radio/stereo cassette, adjustable front seat head restraints, full velour seats and many other refinements.



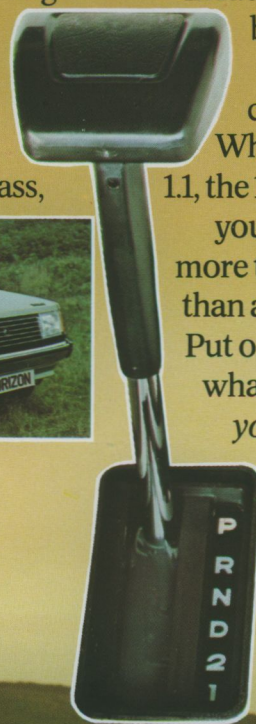


Latest in the Horizon range is the all new SX which features a 1.5 engine with automatic transmission, cruise control, trip computer, bronze tinted glass,

Cubic capacity 1442 cc 82 DIN bhp at 5,600 rpm.
Maximum torque 91 lb ft DIN at 3,000 rpm.
Compression ratio 9.5:1.

Ignition.

Electronic system to ensure constant ignition performance.
12 volt 40 amp/hour battery negative earth system.
Coil and distributor with automatic centrifugal advance and vacuum advance control. 14 mm sparking plugs, alternator charging.

Cooling

Water cooled, closed circuit with expansion bottle.
Electrically operated cooling fan.

Transmission LS, GL & GLS.

Front wheel drive. Four speed, all synchromesh gearbox with centre floor gear change lever 181 mm (7.1 in) diameter single dry plate clutch with hydraulic operation from pendant pedal.

Transmission SX.

Front wheel drive. 3-speed automatic transmission.
Floor mounted selector lever.

Front Suspension

Independent torsion bars with telescopic shock absorbers.
Anti-roll bar.

Rear Suspension.

Independent coil springs with telescopic shock absorbers, trailing arms. Anti-roll bar.

Steering.

Rack and pinion type. Turning circle 10.2 m (33.5 ft).

Brakes.

238 mm (9.4 in) diameter discs at front. 228 mm (9 in) diameter drum at rear with automatic wear adjustment.
Hydraulic dual circuit, vacuum servo assisted.
Brake circuit test button and failure warning light mounted on fascia

Wheels.

Pressed steel. Spare wheel located under luggage compartment.

Tyres.

LS, GL & GLS, 145 x 13 radial ply.
SX, 155 x 13 radial ply.

Petrol Tank.

47 litre (10.3 gallon) capacity, located at rear.

Instruments.

LS & GL. Speedometer with odometer, trip recorder, fuel gauge, water temperature gauge, warning lights for ignition, oil level pressure, trafficator, low fuel level, side lamps, main beam, handbrake, brake fluid level, brake pad wear, choke.

GLS & SX. Same as LS & GL but with the addition of oil pressure gauge, voltmeter.

LS Driver's door mirror, hazard warning flashers, heated rear window, 2 speed screen wipers with flick wipe, electric screen wash, carpet floor covering, illuminated 3-speed heater/blower, reclining front seats, fold down rear seat, childproof rear door locks, glovebox, driver and passenger fascia parcel shelf, 4-armrests, rear parcel tray, soft rim steering wheel, dipping rear view mirror, sunvisors with passenger vanity mirror, face level ventilation, rear fog lamps, interior bonnet release, tailgate lock button, brake fluid tester, interior roof light with courtesy light operated by front doors, concealed inertia reel front seat belts, load adjustable headlamps, 3 ashtrays - 1 front, 2 rear, full faced cloth seats, vinyl boot mat.

GL. Same as LS but with the addition of halogen headlamps, reverse lamps, push button radio, cigar lighter, centre console, glovebox with lid, electric clock, remote control driver's door mirror, illuminated front ash tray, tailgate wash/wipe, front passenger grab handle, doors trimmed to glass level.

GLS. Same as LS & GL but with an addition of laminated windscreen, manual radio/stereo cassette, map reading light, adjustable front seat head restraints, 2-rear passenger grab handles, coat hook, digital clock, front hockeystick arm rests, boot lamp, full faced velour seats, cloth inserts on door trim pads, twin horns.

During 1980 model year a 2-speed heater/blower will be fitted to all Horizon models.

SX. Same as LS, GL & GLS but with the addition of front door pockets, automatic transmission, bodyside mouldings, remote control passenger door mirror, wheel embellisher, rubber bumper inserts, bronze tinted glass, cruise control, trip computer.

Diagnostic Plug

To ensure accurate timing settings, provision has been made for an electro-magnetic probe to be connected to the engine during servicing giving the facility to measure the exact firing point on all four cylinders. This results in more efficient engine operation and aids fuel economy.

'The Protector' and 10,000 mile servicing

Like all Talbot cars, your Talbot Horizon carries the double cover of 'The Protector', a warranty with 12 months unlimited mileage and the 'Extra Care Policy' with free replacement of these major parts - clutch unit, clutch plate, brake discs and pads, brake drums and linings, exhaust, shock absorbers - should they wear out during the warranty period, irrespective of the number of miles driven. Major servicing is required only at 10,000 miles or 12 monthly intervals, with an oil change and brake fluid check at 5,000 miles or six months.

Ask your Talbot dealer for full details. *Cars used for Police and taxi work are excluded from free part replacement. Cars used for competitions are excluded from all the benefits of 'The Protector'.
